- 1.) TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS: The promoter will provide at his/her own expense
- 1 bass cabinet or combo amp (GK MB150 is best)
 - 1 bass head
- -1 Guitar amp (for lap steel) Fender Vibrolux Reverb, Fender Deluxe Reverb or similar

- DRUM SET

- 4 piece vintage jazz kit (Rogers, Ludwig, Slingerland, Gretsch, Leedy, Sonor, etc) or contemporary brand such as Yamaha, Gretsch, Pearl, Slingerland, or anything custom (*please no DW or Mapex*)
- ** sizes listed in depth x diameter **
- bass drum 14" x 20" (18 diameter good too)
- rack tom 8" x 12"
- floor tom (with legs) 14" x 14"
- **snare** 5" x 14" (Ludwig Supraphonic is great!)
- **HEADS**: Single ply coated Ambassador; NO HOLE for bass drum head (but please include blanket, fabric, or similar material for muffling)

HARDWARE

All hardware single braced (please no DW)

- 2 cymbal stands (straight, no booms)
- hi-hat stand with clutch
- 2 snare stands (1 for snare, 1 spare for rack tom)
- bass drum pedal
- stool (round seat please; no motorcycle)
- drum carpet

CYMBALS

All cymbals should be suitable for jazz-- light and flexible at edges; for example, Zildjian K Constantinople or similar

- -Ride cymbal: 20" or 22", very light weight, crash-able
- 2 crash cymbals: 16"-18"
- **Hi-hats** (top and bottom): 14", very light weight

-1 Fender Guitar amp Deluxe Reverb or Twin for Oud (DI box is ok if amp is not possible)

PA SYSTEM

- Must be in Stereo, with 4 onstage monitors
- **Microphones:** Enough to amplify all amps and drums. One talk back microphone placed at front of the stage near oud setup. See stage plot. All microphone stands should be adjustable booms.
